This letter is to inform you that as a result of a security compromise in the Kansas Universal Service Fund (KUSF) bank account, a new account has been established. However, due to the compromise, bank account information will no longer be mailed to KUSF contributors or recipients. Payments received in the former KUSF bank account will be forwarded to the new bank account through March 31, 2009. To ensure your company's KUSF remittances are sent to the appropriate bank account and credited to your company's account, please contact either Mr. Sant or Ms. Reams as soon as possible. If your company remits its KUSF payment via paper check, we strongly urge you to consider changing to electronic remittances at this time.

We hope to make this KUSF change as transparent as possible and appreciate your immediate attention to this matter.
